

*Maximum Night Campground Stay
Pilot Project*
**Saskatchewan Landing Provincial Park
Sagebrush Campground**

This pilot project designates 54 campsites in Sagebrush Campground that have been recently upgraded to electric as **maximum stay** sites. Campers who register in these designated sites are limited to maximum stays of 14 consecutive nights during the peak camping season of Wednesday, June 24 through to Monday, September 7, 2009.

This will allow more Saskatchewan families and visitors to experience a provincial park vacation. We are committed to improving the overall camping experience and to offering everyone the best camping opportunity possible.

The 54 sites for this pilot project are designated as both first-come, first-served sites and Reserve-a-Sites:

- **Sites 1-26 are designated as Reserve-a-Sites:** reservation requests will be accepted as of 9:00 a.m. on Monday, June 8, for stays beginning on Wednesday, June 24.
- **Sites 27-54 are designated as first-come, first-served sites** will be available for stays beginning on Wednesday, June 24 at 9:00 a.m. (when the campground office opens to the public).
- Upon departure from a pilot site at the end of **or part of** a 14 consecutive night stay, a camper or a member of the immediate household will need to wait for 48 hours prior to re-registering or beginning a new reservation within the pilot sites.
- 14-night stays include any combined consecutive night stays within the pilot Reserve-a-Sites and pilot first-come, first-served sites.
- Campers completing a 14 consecutive night stay within the pilot sites may move to any other available site in the park, outside of the pilot project.
- Campers registering in a pilot site will be asked to produce a valid driver's license upon check-in.

Reservation requests for Reserve-a-Sites in this pilot project will be accepted Monday, June 8, for stays beginning on Wednesday, June 24.
